Position Summary:

The Financial Analyst will report to the Manager of Finance in a strategic role. The candidate will be responsible for developing financial models and analyses as well as research to support the development of industry leading electric vehicle charging and infrastructure deployment. The candidate will have strong attention to detail, excellent analytical skills, and ability to complete ad hoc requests and solve challenges that will frequently arise. The candidate will have a background in project finance, investment banking, management consulting, corporate development and/or private equity, preferably within the power & utilities or energy transition sectors.

This position will be located in our Morristown, New Jersey Office, with minimal travel required.

Day-to-day responsibilities will include:

- Creating and maintaining corporate and project level financial models to evaluate new and existing opportunities within the EV charging space including:
 - Development Projects
 - Operating Projects
 - Corporate and project level investments & acquisitions
 - Competitive solicitations from public / private sector organizations and entities
- Pricing of various product offerings and preparation of proposals to customers.
- Conducting scenario and sensitivity analyses to inform key decisions made by the executive team.
- Asset management and tracking of development and operational projects.
 - Work alongside the construction, engineering, procurement, and operations teams to develop and maintain project budgets throughout the project lifecycle.
 - Track project milestones and timing of capital drawdowns, refine forecasts and provide cash flow analysis for both development and operating projects.
 - Complete electric utility rate analysis and forecasting to determine energy costs associated with each project.
 - Work directly with the accounting team and external vendors to maintain financial statements, projections, and budgets on a monthly basis.
- Preparation of investment memorandums and board materials summarizing analyses, financial results, and strategic initiatives.
- Provide the policy team with relevant financial information for state and federal incentive programs and applications.
- Frequent communication with CEO, COO and investors covering financial performance, liquidity, and corporate developments.
- Growing the corporate and strategic finance function by creating and maintaining new and existing processes, while simultaneously engaging in strategic initiatives.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in finance, accounting, engineering, or related field with demonstrated high achievement.
